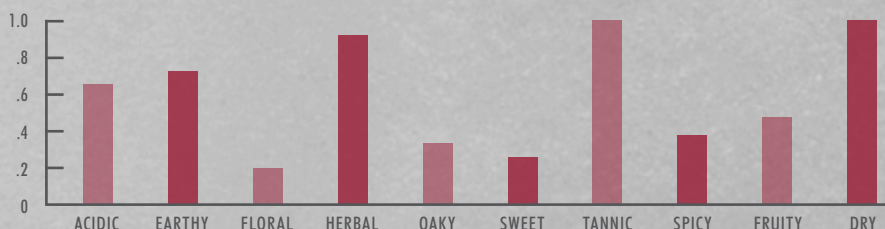

Become spellbound by our handmade blends, produced using small-lot fermentation, native yeast and the extra care required to purely express the classic taste and terroir of their region.

WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2014 harvest produced a large and ripe vintage. The grapes were handpicked at maximum ripeness and underwent a 10-day fermentation in small, open-top fermentors. After completing a full malolactic fermentation, the wines were aged in French oak barrels to provide balance and structure.

TASTING NOTES

This Pinot Noir showcases the finesse and balance Oregon Pinot Noir is known for. A bouquet of rose, fig and oak burst from the glass and give way to flavors of cherry and clove. A hint of oak rounds out the palate and provides smooth tannins. This wine is drinkable now or will benefit with up to 5 years of aging.
