ARTISAN WINEMAKING:

The grapes used in Rascal Pinot Gris are farmed using sustainable vineyard practices. Whole cluster pressing and slow, cool fermentations preserve the natural flavors. There are no other varietals blended in the wine providing for a clean and expressive wine.

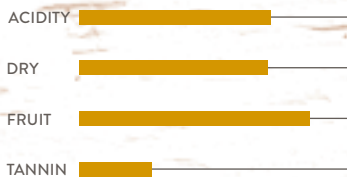
WINEMAKING NOTES:

The grapes for this wine are sourced from the Willamette Valley AVA in Oregon. Warm sunny days and cool nights allow for the grapes to ripen to maturity while maintaining balanced acidity. Once picked, the grapes underwent a cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks to preserve the aromas and flavors.

TASTING NOTES:

Light straw color in the glass with fresh tropical pineapple, citrus, and honeysuckle. The palate has a good weight and shows flavors of white peach, grapefruit, and honey. The acidity is bright and clean while providing structure and a refreshing finish.
